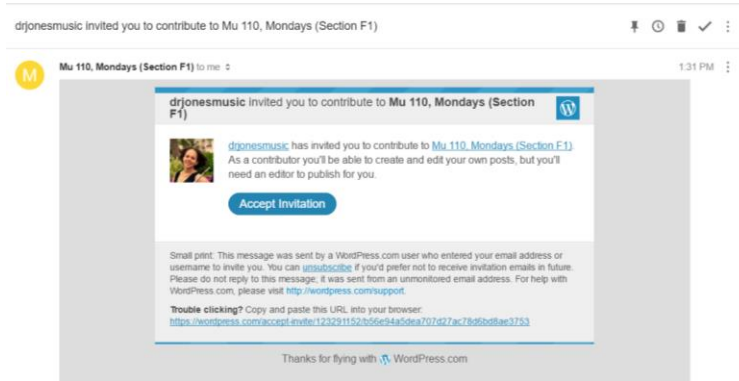
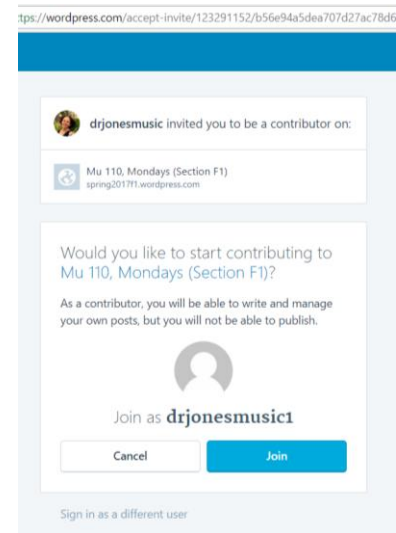


Course Intro Essay: How to create a blog post

1. Accept the email invitation to become a *contributor* to the website for your section of Mu 101 (J2 or C3A). The email you receive will look like this:



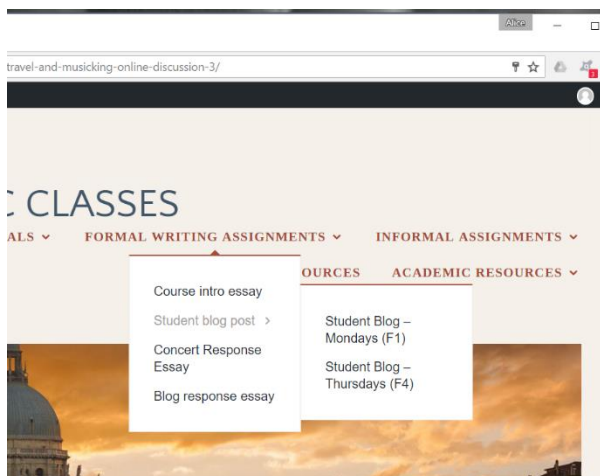
Clicking “Accept Invitation” will take you to a website that asks you “Would you like to start contributing to [website]?” Click “Join.”



2. To come back to the website for your section of Mu 101 in the future, start by going to the class website by typing the URL into the navigation bar (www.drjonesmusic.me). Log into WordPress if you’re not already.

4. Now you’re at the class website AND you’re logged into WordPress. To submit your SBP and to participate in the SBP discussions for your section, use the top navigation bar:

- Formal Writing Assignments
 - Student Blog Post
 - Your section



The “Student Blog Post” link takes you to complete instructions, rubrics, and prompts for all SBP assignments.

The link for each section of Mu 101 takes you to the website for either J2 (Tuesdays) or C3A (Wednesdays). This is where you’ll submit your CIE paragraph and comment on classmates’ posts. It’s also where you’ll submit your own full Student Blog Post later in the term.

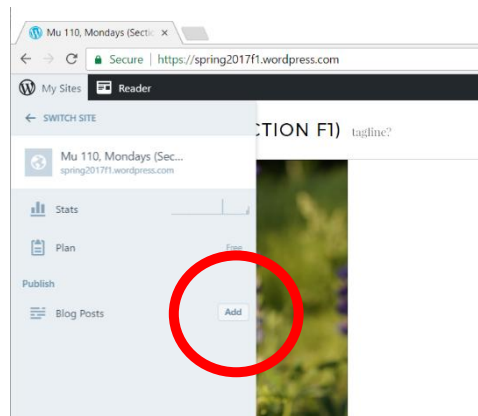
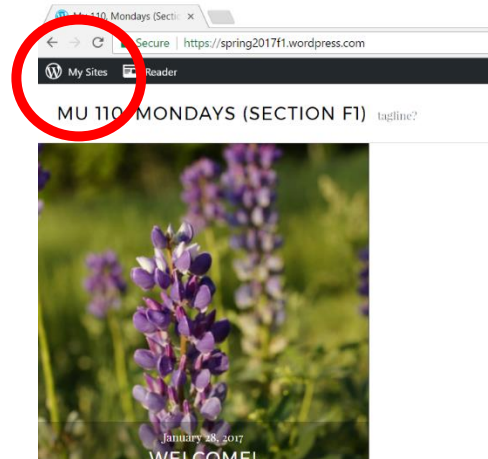
5. Now you're on the website for your section of Mu 101:

- J2 (Tuesdays): <https://fall2017j2.wordpress.com/>
- C3A (Wednesdays): <https://fall2017c3a.wordpress.com/>

To submit your own CIE paragraph, click the “My Sites” button at the top left of the page.

6. Click the “Add” button next to “Blog Posts.” **If this option doesn't appear, it means that you haven't yet accepted the email invitation to become a *contributor* of the website.**

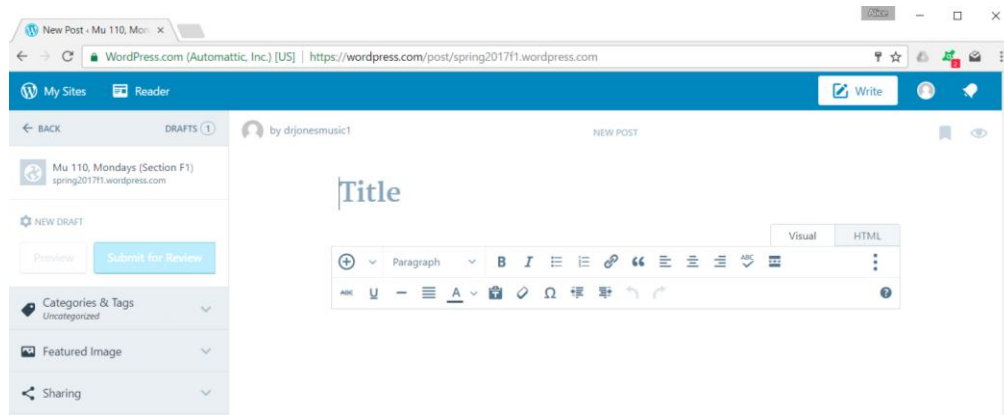
Do NOT create your own website. If you find that you must create a website, it means you skipped Step #1.



7. Create a blog post!

Type your title where it says “Title.” This should be something catchy that makes people want to read what you've written.

Open your word processing program (Word, Pages, etc.) and paste your chosen paragraph from your CIE in the blank body space below the formatting tool ribbon.



8. Submitting your CIE paragraph

Proofread and double check that your CIE reads the way you want it to on the screen—there's a Preview option to the left of your post to see how the final product will appear when published. When you're done, click the blue "Submit for Review" button on the left. This will allow me to publish your post for the rest of the class to read.
